INQUIRY CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS: Remaining MI courses must be chosen from classes labeled with appropriate designation in catalog or course schedule. Some MI requirements are satisfied by major requirements. Substitutions are not allowed after entry.

IC Major Specific Notes | Secondary Education Programs

The majority of requirements on this checklist are mandated by the Illinois State Board of Education. Changes in state licensure requirements must be met at the time they go into effect. Therefore, this could change program requirements, requiring different courses than those listed on the checklist. See your academic advisor with questions regarding this.

The Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP) and the ACT with Writing or SAT used in lieu of TAP are valid for 10 years. All other exams required for licensure are valid for five years from the date of successful passage.

A cumulative GPA of a 2.75 and a 3.0 GPA in the major are required for Teacher Education Programs. GPA is based on Benedictine University courses only.
