We will also travel to Costa Rica on a 10 day study tour to learn firsthand about Costa Rica's environmental record. The study tour is designed to be very interactive with local people and organizations. We will visit and stay in small towns along the Caribbean coast, visiting Tortugaro National Park, Cahuita, Puerto Viego, and the BriBri Indigenous Reserve. The estimated cost of the trip (over spring break) is \$2100 (includes airfare, hotels, meals, in-country transportation, professional translator). A stipend is available to help defray some of the cost. Contact Dr. Thornburg for more information.
