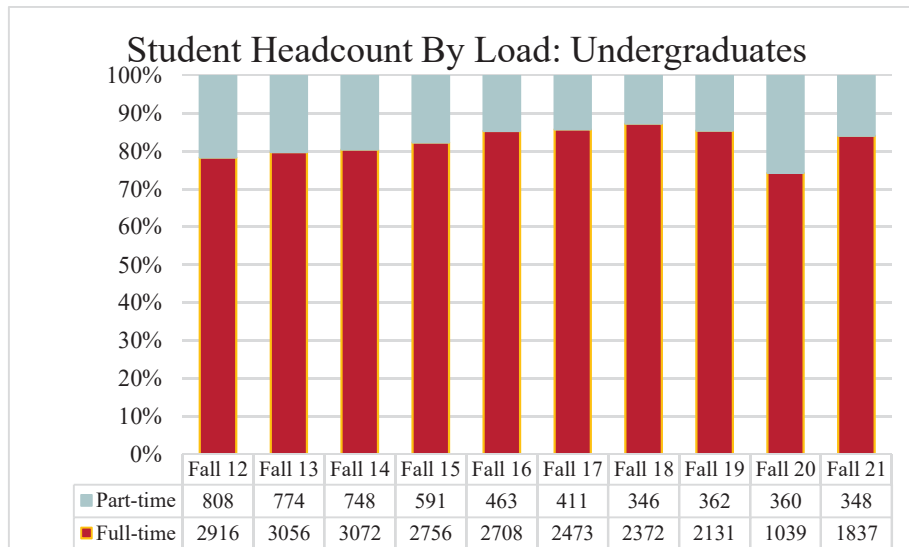

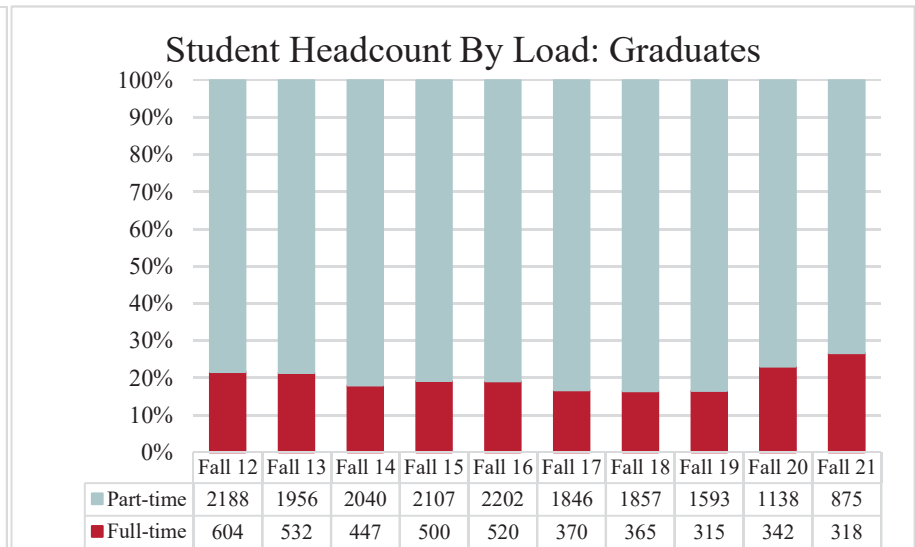

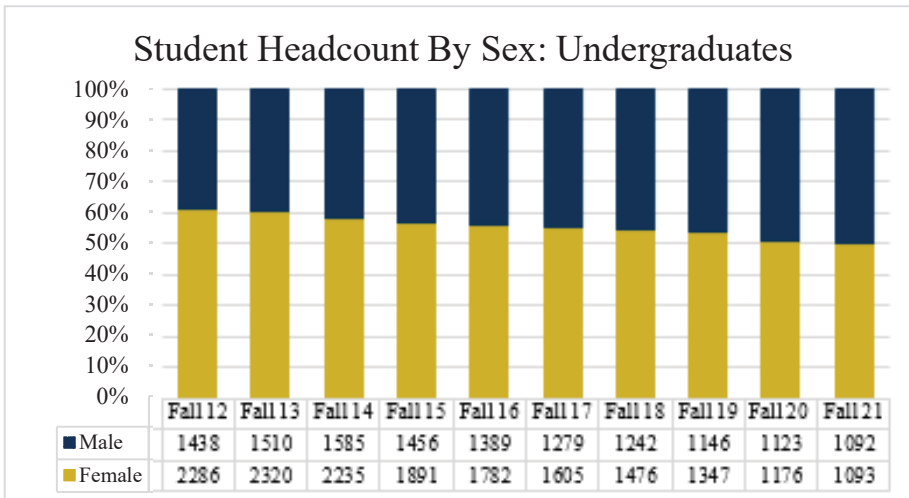

A full-time undergraduate student is enrolled for 12 or more credit hours

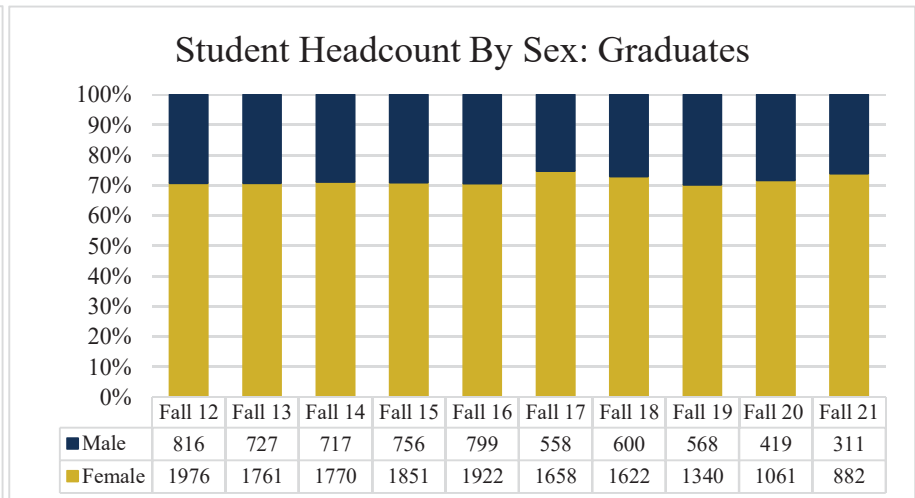

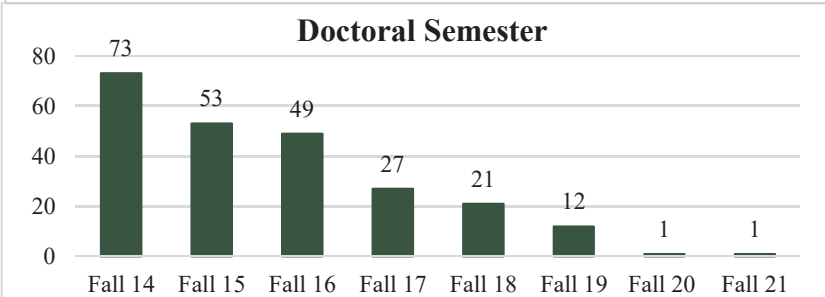
### Student Headcount By Classification



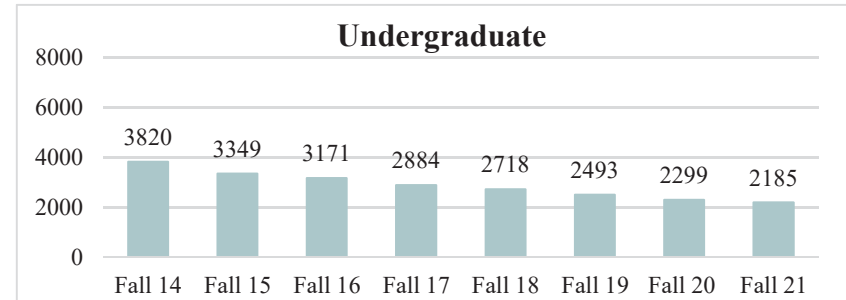

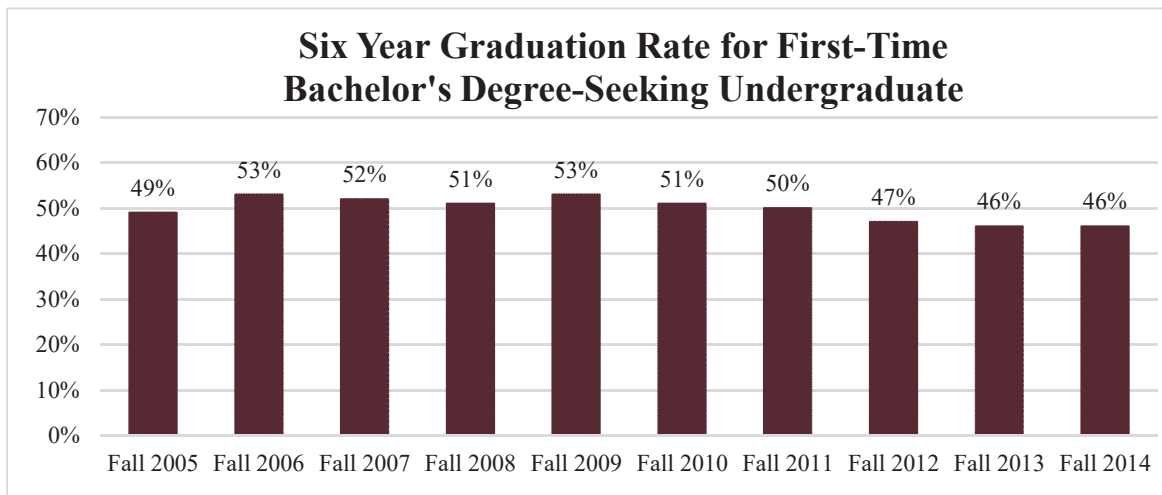
