Dental Program

- Apply for admission to LECOM via AADAS following completion of Benedictine MSIP degree
- MSIP Program Cumulative GPA of 3.3 or higher
- Have a Cumulative Overall GPA and Cumulative Science GPA, including courses taken in the Benedictine University's Master of Science in Integrative Physiology program, as shown on their AADSAS application (GPA≥ 3.4; and Cumulative Science GPA≥ 3.2);
- Meet or exceed the Dental Admission Test (DAT) requirement of 19 in reading comprehension, perceptual ability and academic average.
- No final course grade less than a "C" in the Benedictine University's Master of Science in Integrative Physiology program;
- Shadowing (~100 hrs) in a clinical dental setting is highly recommended but not required; and
- Be recommended by the Director of the M.S. in Integrative Physiology program.
