## **Pharmacy Program**

- LECOM will offer an interview to students enrolled in Benedictine University's Master of Science in Integrative Physiology (M.S.I.P.) program who apply as a traditional applicant to LECON's College of Medicine. To qualify for the interview, the M.S.I.P. student must:
- Have an M.S.I.P. program cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher;
- Have a Cumulative Overall GPA and Cumulative Science GPA, including courses taken in the Benedictine University's Master of Science in Integrative Physiology program (GPA≥ 3.4; and Cumulative Science GPA ≥ 3.2, as of February 1<sup>st</sup> of the year of matriculation or provide proof that these are achievable by the end of the spring term. All GPAs are as calculated by PharmCAS.); and
- No final course grade less than a "C" in the Benedictine University's Master of Science in Integrative Physiology Program.
  - Cumulative Overall GPA\*.....≥ 3.4; and
  - Cumulative Science GPA\* .....≥ 3.2
