Select Learning Objectives

As a general rule, prioritize what you want students to learn by **selecting approximately 3 to 5 objectives** as "Important" or "Essential". When calculating Progress on Relevant Objectives, IDEA weighs Minor/Not Relevant "0", Important objectives "1", and Essential objectives "2".
