BenU Library Code of Conduct

- Be respectful of others.
 - If someone asks you to be quiet, please do so.
 - Verbal, physical, racial or gender harassment of any kind will not be tolerated.
 - Any hazing activity which threatens a person's rights of self-respect, and which disrupts community life, will not be tolerated in the Library.
- Use Library furniture as it is intended to be used.
 - If you move something, please put it back.
 - Refrain from the destruction, defacement, and mutilation of Library materials, displays, artwork, facilities, and equipment.
- Check out items from the Library before taking them with you.
- Keep your personal belongings with you at all times.
- Sports equipment may not be used in the Library.
- Follow the Acceptable Use of Technology guidelines set by IT and the Library.
- Refrain from smoking, vaping, or alcohol use.
- Refrain from inappropriate physical intimacy.
- Wear a shirt and shoes at all times.

Users will be asked to leave the Library if they cannot comply with the BenU Library's Code of Conduct.
